Mayor Tremblay welcomed Lieutenant Mike Gagne and Fire Chief Tracy Roulston to Council Chambers. The delegation briefed council on information received by the Department that would enable the volunteers to act as Medical First Responders (MFR) under the umbrella of Alberta Health Services (AHS). Legal Fire Department met with Alberta Health Services to look at opportunities for the volunteers on the fire department to provide enhanced patient care skills to residents within our community under the Medical First Responder (MFR) program with Alberta Health Services. Alberta Health Services provide a medical director for the oversight of the program and provides liability coverage through the program. Standard First Aid with Enhanced Skills is being recommended by the volunteer organization. Annually every September a grant is available in the amount of \$3000.00 for equipment. Moving forward a bylaw or agreement must be passed by a Council resolution in order to participate in the Medical First Responder program. Mayor Tremblay thanked Lieutenant Gagne and Chief Roulston for the progressive work and information which was provided.
