

By Law #06-95

A Bylaw of the Village of Legal in the Province of Alberta to Authorize the Municipal Council of the Village of Legal, in the province of Alberta, to enter into an agreement with the Town of Bon Accord, the Town of Gibbons, the Town of Morinville, the Town of Redwater to establish inter-municipal quality management plans for the building discipline and the fire discipline.

WHEREAS, Section 3(b)(c) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M.26.1 R.S.A. 1994 and amendments, provides that the purposes of a municipality are to provide services, facilities or other things that, in the opinion of Council, are necessary or desirable for all or a part of the municipality, and to develop and maintain safe and viable communities.

WHEREAS, Section 180(1) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M.26.1 R.S.A. 1994 and amendments provides that a council may act only by resolution or bylaw.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable that the Town of Bon Accord, Town of Gibbons, Town of Morinville, Town of Redwater and the Village of Legal enter into Inter-municipal Quality Management Plans for the Building Discipline and the Fire Discipline.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Legal, duly assembled enacts as follows:

That authorization be given to entering into an agreement with the Town of Bon Accord, Town of Gibbons, Town of Morinville and the Town of Redwater to establish Inter-municipal Quality Management Plans for the Building Discipline and the Fire Discipline; and that the Quality Management Plans be established as outlined in the Agreements, attached hereto.

This bylaw shall be deemed to be in effect upon the third and final reading thereof.
