

Bylaw #17-95

Being a bylaw of the Village of Legal in the Province of Alberta to amend the Subdivision Authority Bylaw (Bylaw 12-95) of the Village of Legal.

WHEREAS Section 623 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1 1994, as amended ("the ACT") requires that a Municipal Council establish a Subdivision Authority by bylaw.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Legal deems it reasonable to amend Bylaw #12-95, the Subdivision Authority Bylaw of the Village of Legal.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Legal, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"3. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY

3.1 The Subdivision Authority of the Village of Legal is hereby established.

3.2 The Subdivision Authority shall consist of four (4) members of the Council appointed by resolution of the Council.

3a. TERM OF OFFICE

3a.1 Subject to Section 3a.2 of this bylaw, each member of the Subdivision Authority shall be appointed at the pleasure of the Council for a term of one (1) year and may be reappointed upon the expiry of the term at the pleasure of Council.

3a.2 Where a member of the Subdivision Authority ceases to be a member of the Council, his appointment to the Subdivision Authority shall terminate.

3b. CHAIRMAN

3b.1 At the first meeting of the Subdivision Authority following the appointment of members each year, a Chairman shall be elected by vote of the majority of the members.

3b.2 A member may be re-elected to the position of Chairman.

3b.3 The Chairman shall preside at the meetings of the Subdivision Authority.

3c. VICE-CHAIRMAN

3c.1 A Vice-Chairman shall be elected at the same time and under the same rules as the Chairman.

3c.2 A member may be re-elected to the position of Vice-Chairman.

3c.3 The Vice-Chairman shall preside at the meetings of the Subdivision Authority Board in place of the Chairman if the Chairman, for any reason, does not preside at the meeting.

3c.4 In the absence of the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman, one of the other members of the Subdivision Authority Board shall be elected to preside.

3d. QUORUM AND MEETINGS

3d.1 A quorum of the Subdivision Authority shall be three (3) members of the Subdivision Authority.

3d.2 The Subdivision Authority shall meet at such intervals as are necessary to consider and decide matters filed with it in accordance with the Act.

3d.3 The Subdivision Authority shall have prepared and maintain a file of written Minutes of the business transacted at all meetings of the Subdivision Authority, copies of which shall be regularly filed with the Council.

3d.4 The Subdivision Authority may make rules as are necessary for the conduct of its meetings, its hearings and its business that are consistent with this Bylaw, the Village of Legal Land Use Bylaw, and the Act."


EFFECTIVE DATE
