

By Law #05-98

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LEGAL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL.

WHEREAS, Section 150 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1 RCA 1994 provides that the Council of the Town may require Council to appoint the Chief Elected Official from among the Councillors.

AND WHEREAS, Council of the Town of Legal deems it desirable to have the Chief Elected Official appointed from among the Councillors.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Municipal Council of the Town of Legal duly assembled and enacts as follows:

THAT the Chief Elected Official of the Town of Legal be appointed by and from the elected Councillors by resolution at the first organizational meeting following a general municipal election and that such appointment be reviewed at each organizational meeting throughout the term of office.

This Bylaw shall be advertised as required by the Municipal Government Act.

This Bylaw shall come into effect and the terms within applied to the Municipal Election of October 19, 1998.


