

By Law #07-97

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LEGAL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND CREATING TITLE TO PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Legal of the Province of Alberta deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to same, and


WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Legal in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creating title to the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

"All that portion of Avenue St. Emile lying between the production easterly of the north and south boundaries of Lot 8, Block 2, Plan 7710U"

"Excepting thereout all mines and minerals"


