

BY LAW #08-99

**A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF LEGAL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO APPOINT A HEAD FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT.**

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Legal will be subjected to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act effective October 1, 1999.


**WHEREAS**, Section 89(a) states that a local public body, by bylaw must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the local public for the purposes of this act,

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Legal in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Legal is hereby appointed as the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Official.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer may delegate such duties under this Act that she sees necessary.


