

BYLAW #04-2004

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LEGAL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO DESIGNATE NON-SMOKING FACILITIES OR PORTIONS THEREIN WITHIN THE TOWN OF LEGAL.**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1 1994 Revised Status of Alberta 1994 and amendments thereto, authorizes the Council to pass bylaws that are considered expedient for promoting the health, safety, morality and welfare of the municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Legal in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1 This By-Law may be cited as **"THE NO SMOKING BY-LAW"**.
  
2. In this By-Law:
  - (a) "Town" means the Town of Legal.
  - (b) "Enforcement Officer" means any Peace Officer of the By-Law Enforcement Officer of the Town of Legal.
  - (c) "No Smoking Area" means an area designated by the Town in which smoking is prohibited.
  - (d) "Smoke" or "Smoking" means the inhaling, exhaling, burning or carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other lighted smoking equipment burning tobacco or any other weed or substance.
  - (e) "Smoking Area" means an area designated by the Town in which smoking is permitted.
  
3. All buildings and vehicles owned or leased by the Town of Legal are hereby declared smoke free and designated as no smoking areas.
  
4. No person shall smoke in a designated no smoking area.
  
5. Notwithstanding the other provisions of this By-Law, the Council of the Town of Legal, upon written application:
  - (a) may, by resolution, designate smoking areas within the Town owned or leased buildings.
  
6. The Town Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to grant permission whereby smoking will be permitted in a Town owned or leased building during a specific occasion or special event.
  
7. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

EFFECTIVE DATE


This Bylaw shall come into force upon third and final reading.
