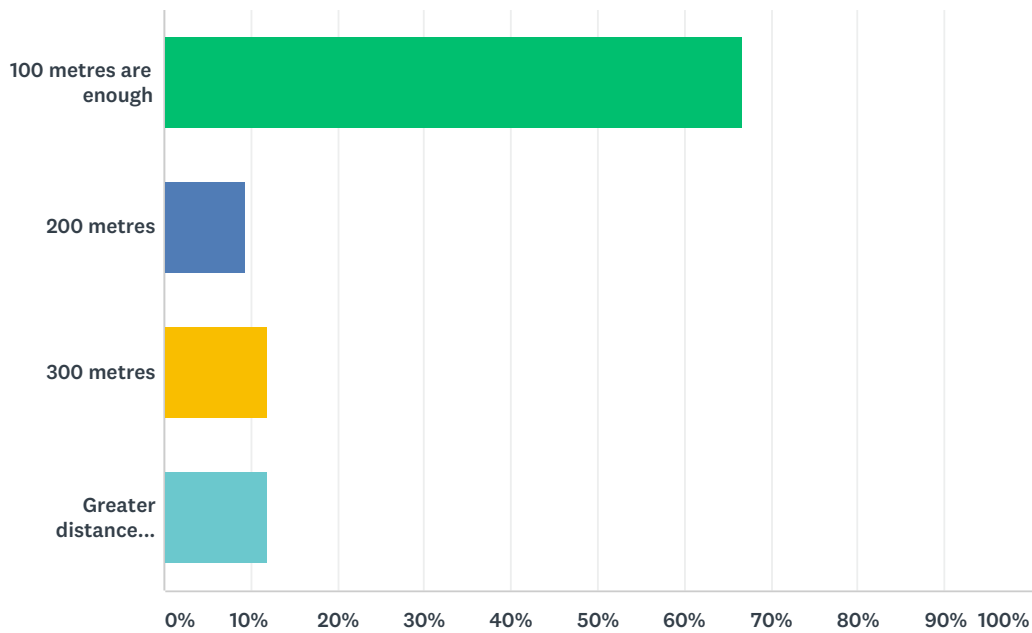

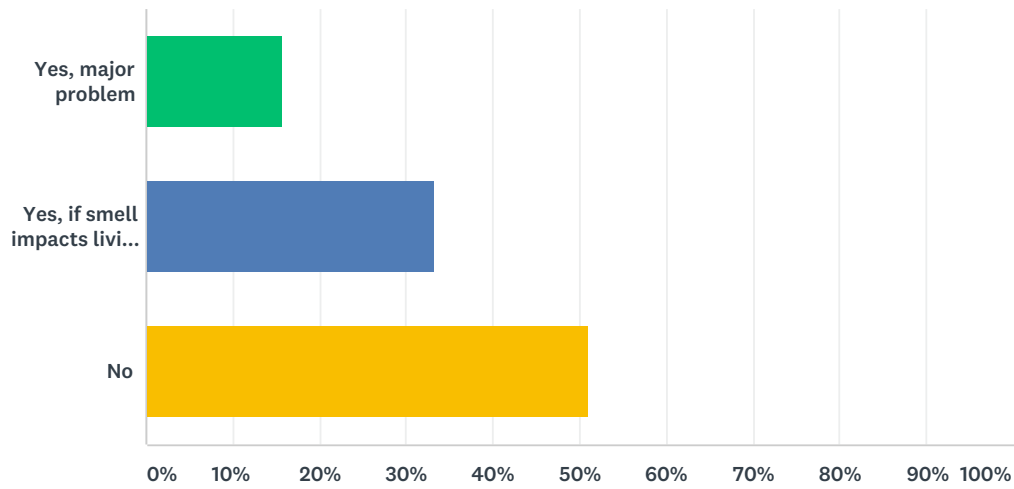

Q5 Is a residential dwelling located above a retail cannabis store in a mixed-use district a problem?

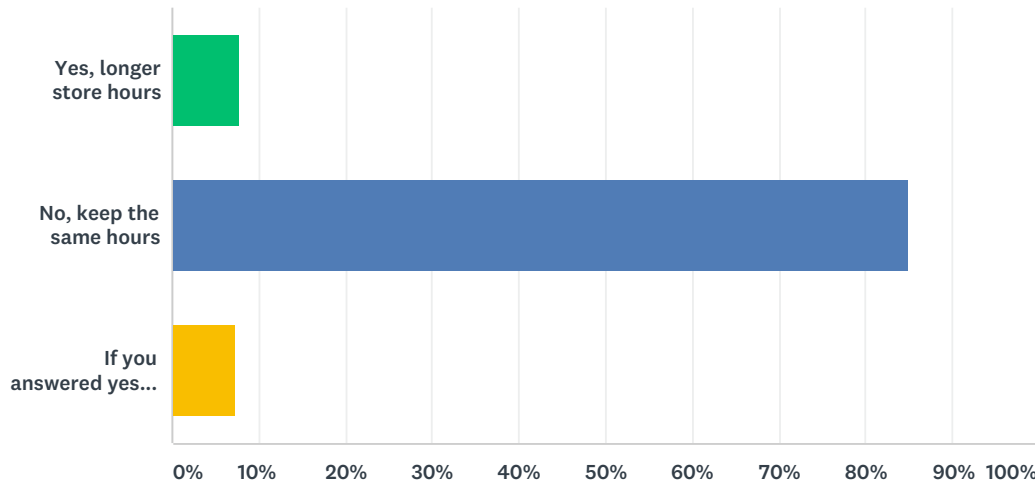

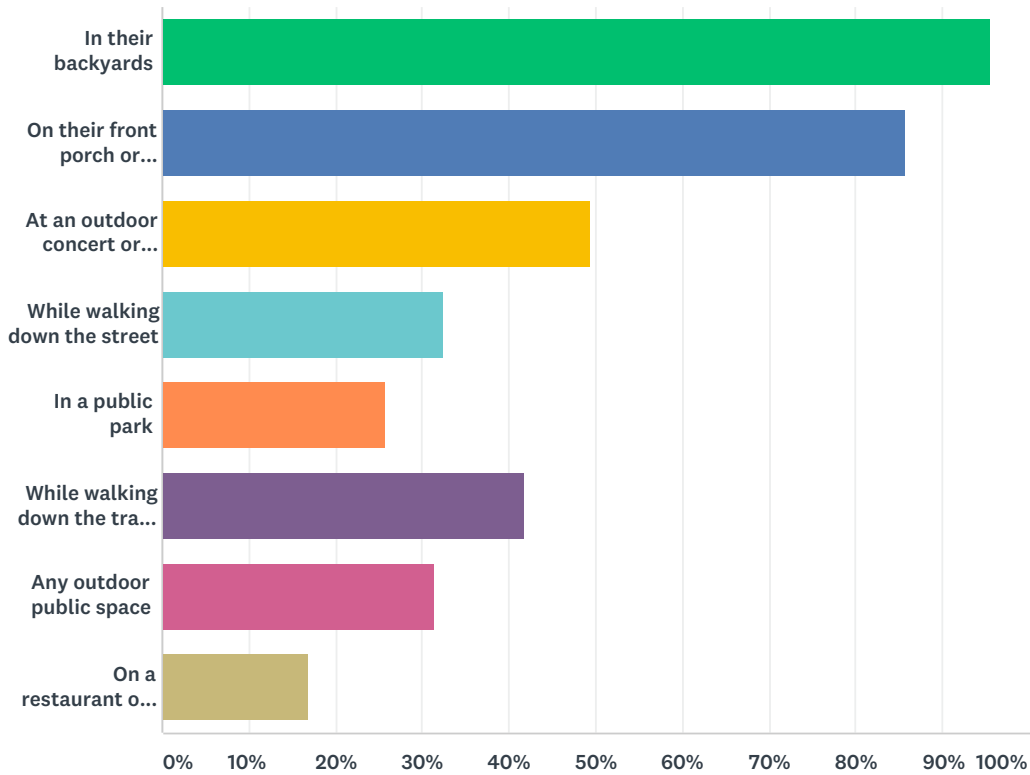

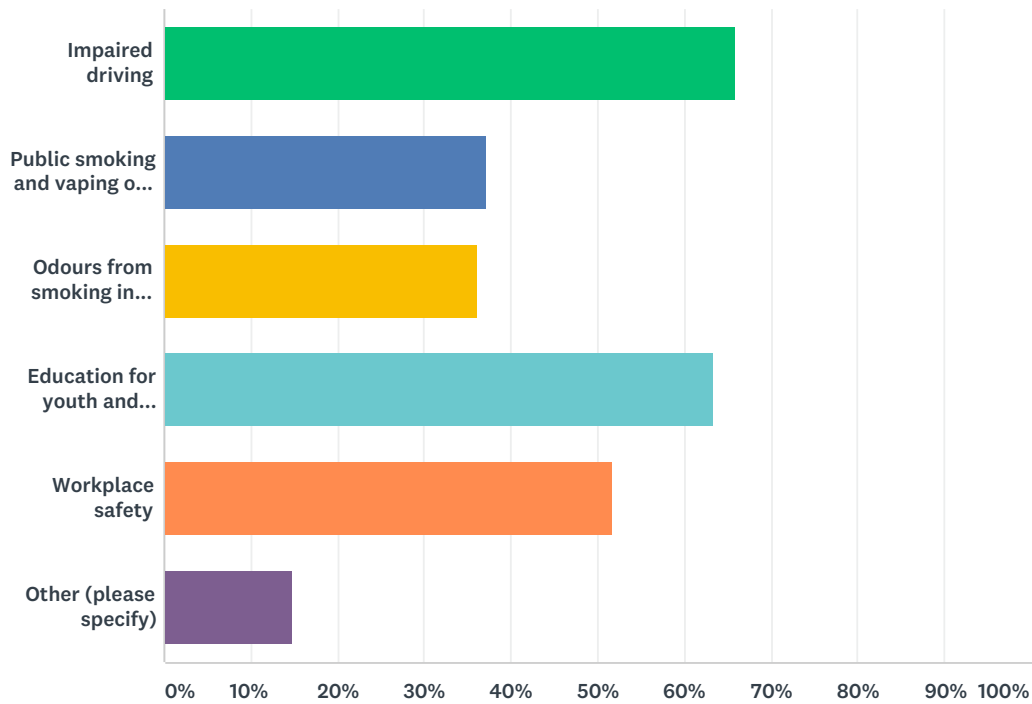
