### **GFL - Waste, Recycle & Organics Contract Proposal**

Mayor Tremblay welcomed Lorenzo Donini and Tamara Chubb from GFL Environmental to present Council with information on a Waste, Recycle and Organic program. Lorenzo's presentation included information on the dedicated staff, fleet strategy, organics processing, waste disposal, collection methodology and program advantages.

**Dedicated Staff** – Wade Chernichan and Tamara will continue to be point of contact for the Town of Legal.

**Fleet Strategy** - Currently has over 40 automated side load collection vehicles, including full time backup equipment.

**Organics processing** - Includes food waste such as vegetable husks, fruit peels, meat trimmings, left-over, paper materials used for containing food items (waxed paper). Also includes all yard waste including grass clippings, garden and hedge pruning, small sticks, branches and leaves.

**Waste Disposal** – Numerous contracts and relations with registered and stringently monitored class II Landfills including the Roseridge Waste Commission and the Thorhild Regional Landfill.

**Recyclables Processing** – GFL is currently making some changes to its Acceptable Items on Recycling, namely restricting the inclusion of non-deposit and many lower grade glass items. GFL has strong continuing relationships with many markets developed locally by Ever Green. Approximately 15% of the Town of Legal's material by weight is landfilled as residual, much of this is as a result of the non-marketable materials.

**Collection Methodology** – Automated collection for Waste and Organics is more reliable, more efficient and provides a much cleaner and professional appearance. GFL can also provide Christmas tree collection and mulching, large item collections, etc. Carts are chipped.

**Program Advantages** – GFL is the foremost residential waste collection company in Alberta with the widest range operations and the largest collection Fleet. GFL owns and operates its own Waste transfer stations, Landfills, Compost Facilities and Recycling Facility, and has the capacity in the form of collection Staff and Equipment; as well as experience providing a wide range of services.

**Occupational Health & Safety Presentation – Bill 30, Changes to OH&S Act**

Melissa McDonald, OH&S Officer with the Government of Alberta presented Council with information on Bill 30 regarding the changes to OH&S Act which will be coming into force on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. Melissa will forward information to the CAO.

**Legal West Sewer Line Feasibility Study**


