Definitions:

Permitted Use: means the use of land or a building provided for in the Land Use Bylaw #05-2013 for which a development permit shall be issued upon application having been made, provided that all of the regulations of the Land Use Bylaw, and all of the matters left to the discretion or the satisfaction of the Development Authority, have been satisfied to the satisfaction of the Development Authority.

Discretionary Use: means the use of land or a building provided for in this Land Use Bylaw for which a development permit may be issued upon an application having been made.

"Subdivision and Development Appeal Board" (SDAB) means a Subdivision and Development Appeal Board appointed pursuant to Town's Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw and the Act.
