Another area of focus is vegetation management. Problematic vegetation increases costs and decreases productivity and reliability. Fortis would like municipalities to assist in reducing problematic vegetation by helping to educate residents with proactive vegetation planning and supporting FortisAlberta's vegetation management practices.
