The Chief Administrative Officer provided a tour for Council of the Sturgeon Valley Fertilizers Sports Centre. A lot of work has been completed, and the facility is making progress toward being ready for the grand opening scheduled for October 3 and 4, 2025.

DELEGATION - Darcy Brisson & Duane Hudec, Citadel Ball Diamond Score Clock

Mayor Tremblay welcomed Duane Hudec to discuss the project of the Citadel Diamond Score Clock. The score clock is scheduled to arrive on October 9, 2025. The sign is computer operated with a wireless remote, which would be stored in the Legal Minor Ball shed. The score board will be part of the community and can be utilized by teams using ball diamonds. Once installed and operational, Legal Minor ball is proposing to sign the score clock over to the Town of Legal, who will store the battery unit in the shop over the winter and ensure that the Score clock is properly insured.

SVF Sports Centre Grand Opening

There will be free food, swag and self-guided arena tours. The Cabaret planned for Saturday will run until 2:00 A.M. There is a maximum room capacity of 300 people.

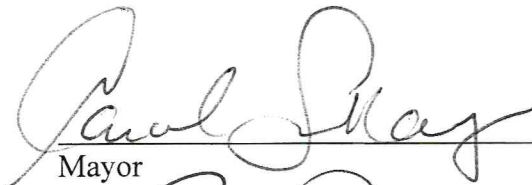
